APA Art Contest Guidelines

The overall theme of the artwork should be **“Children Act Fast - So Do Poisons”** or **“Poisonings Span a Lifetime”**. Messages may be word for word or the wording may be altered as long as the theme remains the same. Entries should illustrate a message that communicates the contest theme. The message should be indicated on the artwork.

Art will be judged on: Quality of artwork, creativity, colorfulness, whether or not they comply with the contest rules and whether they illustrate a message that communicates the theme.

- * Design should be on 8 ½ X 11 paper. Picture may be horizontal or vertical.
- * Contestant must do all the work.
- * Use crayons, acrylics, colored markers, watercolors or colored pencils.

* Entries should not include any state or regional logos or symbols. Trademark symbols or characters (such as cartoon characters) are also prohibited.

* Completed entry form is required for all submissions.

* Spelling counts!

* Submitted entries to this contest become the property of the Alabama Pharmacy Association and will not be returned. Entry into this contest implies consent and permission for the Alabama Pharmacy Association to reproduce, publish, circulate, display on website, to use as advertising or marketing purposes for the Alabama Pharmacy Association.
